Community Living North Grenville actively supports 110 individuals with an intellectual disability and their families throughout the communities of North Grenville through an individualized planning process.

Our name "Community Living" reflects the growing understanding that the right to live a fully integrated life within the community - to live, to go to school, to work, to enjoy recreation and to be active in retirement - belongs to us all. It reflects the aspirations of persons with developmental intellectual disabilities to be included in the fabric of community life.

Support is provided through a wide variety of services which include, employment, work experience, school to work, leisure, recreation, supported independent living, 24 hour residential support, out of home respite for both children and adults and special services at home. We support each individual in realizing their best possible future.

With changing demographics Community Living is planning and adapting to the needs of our aging population and their aging family members. At the opposite end, we are preparing to support the growing needs of younger families including children with Autism, as they mature through the teen years into adulthood.

Community Living and inclusion involves not only the direct support individuals with an intellectual disability receive from us, but the support of the communities in which people live.

Who are our members? Many have a son, daughter, brother or sister who is identified as having an intellectual disability. People who themselves have an intellectual disability are members. Churches, businesses and other community leaders also belong. We all belong to Community Living North Grenville for the same reason. We support full inclusion of people who are identified as having an intellectual disability in all aspects of community living.

A strong local membership in Community Living provides not only a strong voice for individuals with an intellectual disability and their families, but plays an important role through networking and advocacy to include supported individuals in the broader community and its economy. Inclusion provides opportunities for respectful and valued relationships.
